## POST OP INSTRUCTIONS FOR EAR WOUNDS

Dear Patient,

When we have an ear wound with exposed cartilage, it is necessary to use a vinegar solution instead of hydrogen peroxide. While you follow the instructions outlined in the wound sheet, you will substitute this "vinegar solution" in place of "hydrogen peroxide".

## VINEGAR SOLUTION FOR SOAKING

- 1. Boil one (1) quart of water in large pot.
- 2. Add 1/2 cup of vinegar; either white or red will do.
- 3. Let cool until warm.
- 4. Place in a clean jar, such as a juice jar which has been washed and cleaned in the dishwasher, or in boiling water.
- 5. Clean the wound as instructed, using this warm vinegar solution in place of the hydrogen peroxide.
- 6. Wet a clean wash cloth with this warm vinegar solution and apply the wash cloth to the ear for 5 or 10 minutes. This will make the wound easier to clean and care for.
- 7. Apply dressing as instructed.
- 8. The vinegar solution may be stored in the refrigerator and re warmed before each use.
